1. Agenda from email
2. Code of Points will come in an ebook, not a app.
 - a. Only currently works on Mac
 - b. JO Program Video (100 videos)
 - c. Understanding Scoring section
3. New Trampoline scoring for Level 1 – Elite
 - a. TR scoring will change. Scores will be calculated with 2 “E” scores and 1 “HD” score for ALL Levels.
 - b. The CRASH Rule – for the JO Program will now mirror that of the Elite Program. Old way: Soles of feet, new way: Preparation for Landing
 - c. The 3.0 Deduction for Shoulder Height in the JO Program for Tumbling will go away
 - d. Level 8-10 1st Routine is a Voluntary Routine with Requirements vs a Compulsory
4. Status of Board
 - a. We need a strong group of volunteers
 - b. Want to be able to hold meets or have people ready to backfill
 - c. Making sure that parents are ready to judge.

6. State Clinic: **There has been some discussion of doing a JOINT STATE Clinic with Maryland, 21 January, 2018. This clinic would be at Fairland. Though we had people express interest in a state clinic, we did not have people run the clinic.**
 - a. Wolfgang will be the Clinic Director and work with Fairland’s Tom Hamblin to coordinate. Laura Ingle and Chris Isenberg agreed to assist.
 - b. Novaks, Dulles, and Flip Over tentatively agreed to register
 - c. Would be able to have a Cat.1 Judges’ Clinic (only way except at Regional Clinic or Nationals)
7. Question from Paul Shlbani: Will the state pay for the Judges certification? Concern for the lack of judges. Everyone agreed to vote as a part of financial discussion.

8. State Meet will be at Flip Over. Flip Over doesn't have regulation floor, so we might need other people to help with equipment. Erin will send out more information.
9. Mobility rules – can't hold mobility meet until after Jan.1st, but you can have athlete compete at the level that they already mobilized to.
10. Finances – we have about \$10,000. We have about \$2000 to spend on athlete's expenses,
 - a. Fund judges' course – they had to submit proof that you judge State or Flip Over. Maximum of \$145 – Everyone voted yes. Estimate of \$500
 - b. Athlete's scholarships – Brandon K from Capital and Nick Melloni - \$500
 - c. Need to set up a policy for future.
